Traffic Safety >>>

These guidelines are the collaborative response of a traffic study conducted by the Strathcona County School Traffic Safety Partnership (SCSTSP) which includes the county as well as law enforcement.

FLOW OF TRAFFIC

- Consider Hawkins Crescent a one-way street during our pick-up and drop-off times: Enter Hawkins Crescent at its west access.
- You should NOT be turning left into our parking lot.
- When entering the parking lot, keep right (close to the pylons).
- One lane of traffic. (ECDT Teachers or visitors may be parking at this time, please be respectful if they need to go by you).

WHERE TO DROP OFF YOUR KIDS

Drop off only in front of the playground or in front of the pylons in the parking lot.

Drivers should remain in their vehilcle. 4-way flashers indicate to the monitors that your child needs assistance.

If possible, please try to have your child ready to exit on the passenger side.



PARKING

Avoid parking on the West Side of Hawkins Cres. across from the school. This is a key contributor to congestion and jay-walking, one of the biggest risks in school zones.

During drop off and pick-up our the SCSTSP encourages this to be a **one-way street**. If you are parking across the street from the school on Hawkins Crescent, a Peace Officer may approach you to review the guidelines in our safety partnership.

CAN I PASS A Vehicle?

At times, vehicles in front of you may take some extra for their children to exit the vehicle. Please be patient.

If there is a long delay in the line, please **wait for a traffic monitor** to indicate that you may pass.

If passing requires you to back up, please follow the direction of the monitor as we have had a near misses in the parking lot.

DO NOT BLOCK RESIDENTIAL DRIVEWAYS.



PARKING LOT

- Use only the stalls designated on the map (lime green).
- Do not park in the designated staff parking stalls. These are reserved for École Claudette-et-Denis-Tardif staff.
- Please do not use these stalls for morning drop off.
- Visitor stalls are meant for:
 - assisting your child carrying items into the school;
 - if you must enter the school for any reason;
 - if you are volunteering.
- Please do not use the visitor parking to await your children. Use the drop off/ pick up zone (bright blue on our map).

Please be vigilant when backing out of spots. We have had some near-misses and fender benders in the parking lot recently and student safety is of utmost concern.
