

New Horizons School requests applications for a ***part-time Grade 6 teaching position***. This is a temporary .58 FTE position, commencing August 26, 2025 and ending June 24, 2026. The teacher shall possess, or be eligible for, an Alberta teaching certificate. The successful candidate will teach Math and Language Arts as well as additional courses in collaboration with the co-teacher. The position will be scheduled in full or half days so as to allow the successful applicant the opportunity to substitute if desired. The successful candidate will be eligible for insurance benefits.

Preference will be given to candidates who demonstrate the following qualities:

- Experience teaching at the upper elementary level..
- Experience working with gifted students and/or training in gifted education would be an asset.
- Experience working with and managing Individual Program Plans (IPPs).
- A demonstrated ability to differentiate instruction, use formative assessments, and be competent working with students with varying levels of social, emotional, and intellectual needs.
- Excellent communication skills.
- An ability to work collaboratively with grade level partners, other colleagues, administrators, and parents.
- A demonstrated ability to effectively use learning technology for instruction.
