Earth Day: Students participated in Earth Day activities throughout the last number of weeks. One activity was the Strathcona County Shoe Drive. Admissions: We have completed admissions and are just finishing up our communications to new parents with information on registration.

New Classrooms: We will be getting 2 new modular classrooms installed for use beginning in the 2025-2026 school year. ECDT will be removing their modular classrooms as they move into their new building and we will be adding on additional learning space on the south side of the primary wing of the school. This work may begin in June and I will be meeting with Alberta Infrastructure at the end of May to discuss the details of the installation.
