- To identify student needs early, including social and emotional needs.
- To gather ideas about learning, engagement, school culture, and future planning.
- To ensure decisions are based on real experiences, not assumptions.

How Your Feedback Is Used

- Shared with school leadership and the Board of Directors.
- Reviewed alongside surveys and student learning information.
- Used to guide school goals, priorities, and improvement plans.
- Helps shape programs, student supports, and learning opportunities.
- Past feedback has already led to real changes at our school.

How Information Is Shared

- Key themes and ideas are summarized and shared with decision-makers.
- Feedback is reflected in school plans and updates.
- We focus on common ideas and themes, not individual comments.
- You may see changes over time that reflect what you shared.
