Update: Adjustment to NHCS Board Election Cycle

At the February 18, 2026, meeting, the Board of Directors unanimously approved a change to the annual Board election cycle. This adjustment is intended to strengthen governance continuity, improve Board effectiveness, and better align Board work with the school year and long-term strategic priorities of New Horizons Charter School. These changes will take effect this school year, and more board election information will be shared in the coming months.

What is changing?

Beginning this year, the NHCS Board election process will move from the current October timeline to a late May–June timeline. This includes:

- Notice of the Special General Meeting (SGM) issued in late May
- Nomination period in late May and early June
- Board elections and SGM held in mid-June
- Organizational Board meeting immediately following the election
- Board orientation and retreat held in August
- Committee work begins in September at the start of the school year

Why this change?

The previous October election cycle created several governance challenges:

- Newly elected Board members were joining after the school year had already begun, limiting their ability to contribute fully to early-year planning and decision-making.
- Board committees and orientation often did not begin until late fall, reducing productivity and continuity.
- Outgoing members sometimes completed terms after their children had left the school, making participation more difficult.

By moving elections to June, newly elected Directors can:

- Participate in summer orientation and Board planning
- Begin the school year fully prepared and informed
- Engage in committee work from September onward
- Support stronger continuity, institutional memory, and strategic oversight

This revised timeline also aligns more effectively with the school's K–12 expansion, capital planning work, and ongoing governance priorities.

What does this mean for parents?

New Horizons remains a parent-driven charter school, and parent voice and participation continue to be essential to our success. The new timeline simply allows the Board to operate more efficiently and effectively while maintaining full transparency and opportunities for engagement.

We strongly encourage parents and guardians to:

- Consider serving on the Board of Directors
- Volunteer on Board committees
- Attend the Special General Meeting and participate in voting
- Stay engaged in school governance and community initiatives like School Council and FANHS

Further information regarding nomination procedures and election details will be shared with families later this spring.
